

<u>Cast Change Under Anesthesia: Your child is having their cast changed in the operating room.</u>

- 1. This will be a short procedure, requiring sedation.
- 2. Your child will have their cast removed while asleep, their extremity washed, their wounds assessed and re-dressed.
- 3. A new cast will be applied. A leg/ankle brace (AFO) might be molded in the operating room.
- 4. Your child will be able to put weight on their leg following the cast change. Please use the cast shoe when he/she is walking and active.
- 5. Keep the cast clean and dry.
- 6. No pain medications should be required following the cast change.
- 7. We will see you in clinic in approximately 4 weeks to have the cast removed and start increasing activities!
